### **Thinking Strategies**



### **Connecting:**

Proficient thinkers notice pieces of text that relate to or remind them of—their lives and prior knowledge.



## Questioning:

Proficient thinkers ask questions and pursue answers of the author, of themselves, and of the text.



### Drawing Inferences:

Proficient thinkers combine prior knowledge and textual information to draw conclusions and interpret facts.



#### Determining Importance

Proficient thinkers identify big ideas and to diminish focus on less important details.



## Predicting

Proficient thinkers continually wonder about the text using text clues and prior knowledge to think about what might come next.



#### Self-Monitor/Self-Evaluate:

Proficient thinkers use an inner voice to evaluate their understanding of a text and apply strategies to enhance comprehension.



# Synthesizing

Proficient thinkers combine new information from the text with prior knowledge to form new ideas or interpretations from a variety of sources.



#### **Understanding Unknown Words:**

Proficient thinkers use prior knowledge, context clues, similar word forms, prefixes, suffixes, and roots to understand unknown words.
